- 5. What are the two biggest issues affecting your international students' ability or desire to persist at your institution?
  - How would an IEM group (or at least collaboration) impact these issues?
- 6. What are the two biggest institutional barriers to addressing the above issues to improve the persistence of international students?
  - How would an IEM group (or at least collaboration) help to overcome these barriers?
